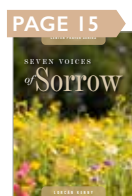

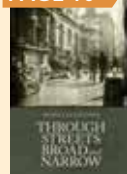


We have a wonderful array of lifestyle books and informative non-fiction books to share with you.

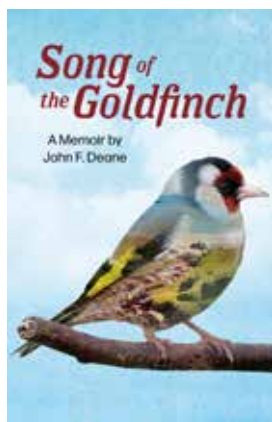

Song of the Goldfinch

A Memoir by JOHN F. DEANE

John F. Deane is a writer and poet. He has had eight collections of poetry published in Manchester by Carcanet, including *Naming of the Bones* (2021). He spent five years as a Holy Ghost novice and seminarian; studied poetry and faith and has published several books of essays on poets of faith, such as Hopkins, Herbert, Heaney and Kinsella. He is the founder of Poetry Ireland and Dedalus Press. He has taught poetry and faith in Boston College as Burns scholar and in Loyola University, Chicago, as Teilhard de Chardin visiting scholar.

Song of the Goldfinch is a beautifully written faith memoir tracing John F. Deane's time as a strict Roman Catholic on Achill Island to his faith as it stands at present. This memoir is a vivid journey through his time spent as a novice and seminarian, through discovery of alternative Christian approaches, all of it in prose form, but linked by poems, both published and unpublished. The book offers insights and experiences that are unique to him as an individual and published poet, and yet wholly relevant to Christian faith in our difficult times.

'In *Song of the Goldfinch* Deane traces the delicate thread of poetry-making and faith-making from an idyllic childhood on the wild shores of the island of Achill, through his youthful experiences as a seminarian, to the mature understanding of old age. He evokes without sentimentality a world of wonder, as well as a journey through momentous change in the Catholic church. His poetry shows us unequivocally how the natural world points to the divine, and how the human world must recognise that. His descriptions of an enchanted Achill bring this world vividly before our eyes: we hear the sea, we see the mountains, we feel and smell the breath of an Atlantic wind that has blown across an ocean of faith and time to reach him'.

Hilary Davies is a poet, translator and critic; her fourth collection is *Exile and the Kingdom*, Enitharmon, 2016.

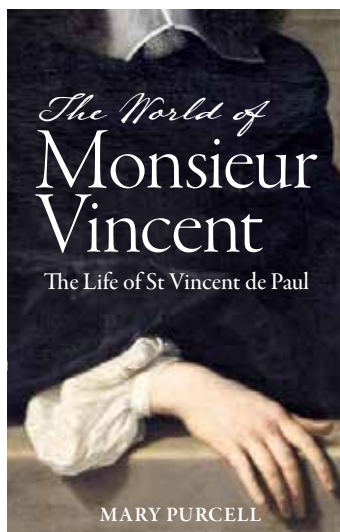

The World of Monsieur Vincent

The Life of St
Vincent de Paul

MARY PURCELL

Renowned writer and historian **Mary Purcell** was a prolific author of Church histories and biographies in the latter half of the twentieth century. She wrote accounts of the lives of such figures as Matt Talbot, St Ignatius of Loyola and Peter Faber.



The life of St Vincent de Paul, the great apostle of charity, is one of the most inspiring of all the Christian saints and his legacy is visible today through the internationally recognised charity that bears his name. In *The World of Monsieur Vincent*, Mary Purcell gives readers a fascinating portrait of the saint who saw 'Christ agonising in every human being who suffered, and who spent a lifetime in trying to assuage that agony'.

Both the grandeur and the misery of life in seventeenth-century France is vividly recaptured by the author as she traces Vincent de Paul's long life (1580–1660). Here again we meet the young peasant, the priest, the captive slave, the religious reformer, and the founder of two great religious orders – the Vincentians and the Daughters of Charity – whose work continues today. The wealth of historical detail included in *The World of Monsieur Vincent*, first published in 1966, makes it a particularly valuable study of both a renowned saint's life and the turbulent times in which he lived.

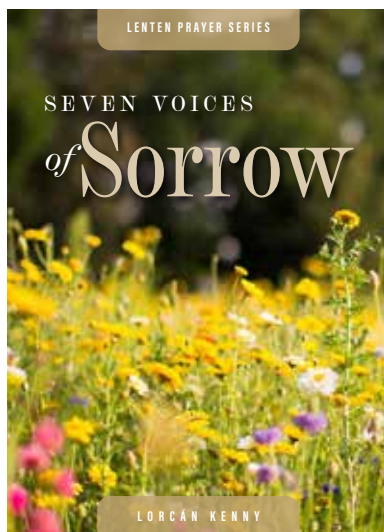

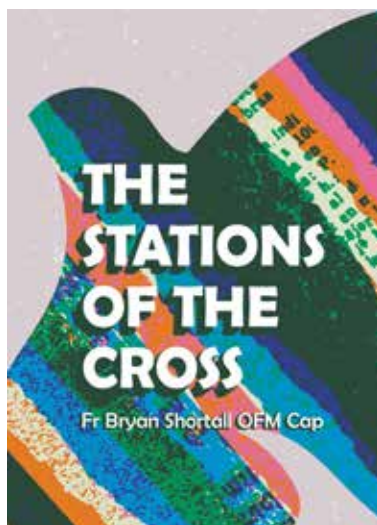

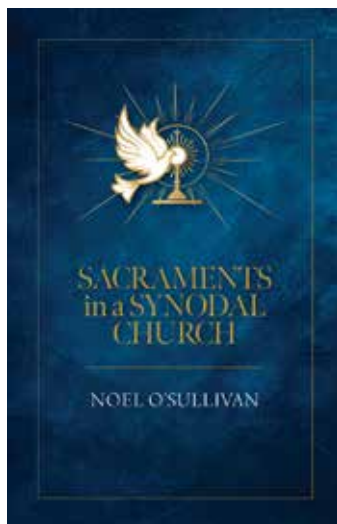

He has been a parish priest in two different parishes in Cork city. He has spent ten years teaching systematic theology to seminarians and lay students at Maynooth, at undergraduate and post-graduate level. Sacramental theology was part of his responsibilities throughout this period.

It exposes the weaknesses in the way sacraments are 'used' as cultural rites of passage or a means of showcasing a school. The way in which synodality is interpreted in the book provides a means of breaking out of this truncated view. It proposes, for example, that parents who wish their children to receive Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist should be offered courses so that they understand the richness and responsibility of presenting their children for these sacraments.

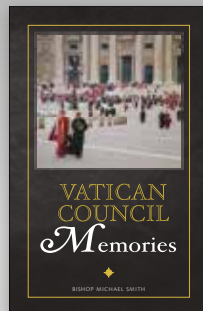
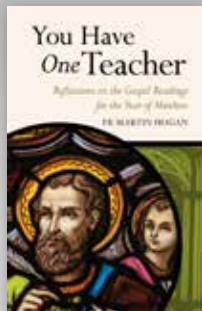
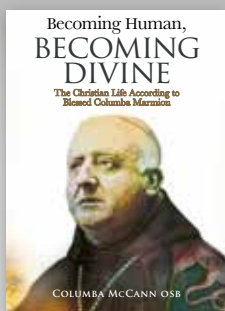
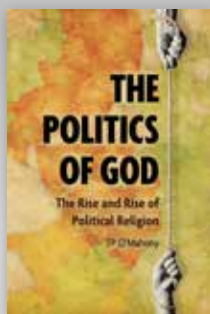
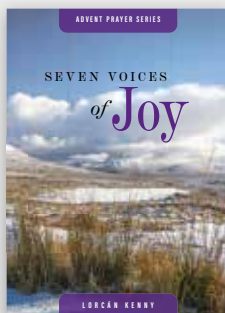
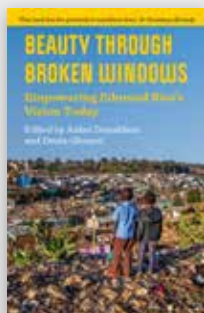
Five main themes dominated Cardinal Daly's moral leadership: the sanctity of human life and love, the imperative of justice, the evil of violence, respect for the gift of the environment and the importance of religious education.

He was dedicated to reconciliation among Christians and to the work of peace in Northern Ireland.

Bishop Joseph Duffy described Cardinal Daly as having a 'unique talent for the written word which he communicated day in and day out to the mass media as well directly to his flock' and referred to his 'relentless efforts over a long lifetime to find an entry for the Church's teaching into the mainstream of public discourse.' Cardinal Sean Brady saw him as a 'prophetic, renewing and transforming figure in a time of immense change in the history of Ireland'.
